Regent Family Residence is a transitional residence for 140 families, providing 24-hour security, on-site childcare, classrooms, and recreational space. A full range of supportive services provides the help families need to achieve independence and obtain permanent housing.

- Prepare participants for semi annual performances.
- Debrief with staff after each session, reporting any concerns or questions.

Qualifications Needed:

- Must be organized and able to give and receive instructions.
- Must be 17 years or older.
- Must be reliable, responsible and able to maintain appropriate boundaries.
- Must enjoy teaching dance to children and young adults.
- Background in dance a plus.

Training and orientation includes a program tour and an introduction to Volunteers of America.
