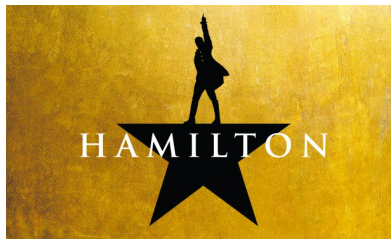


Our Gala is Fast Approaching!
